As always, we will need lots of helpers to set up, run and, most importantly, pack up the fayre on Friday 2nd December.

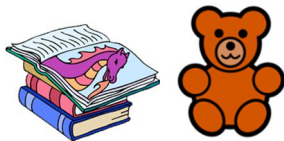
